Participants Should Come Prepared With:

- * Skates– must be properly fitted, sharpened and single bladed. Beginners tend to learn better in figure skates, but hockey skates are acceptable. Hockey skates are required for the Beginning Hockey class. Figure skates are required for Jump & Spin. A limited number of rental skates are available for \$2 per pair, per session, on a first come, first served basis.
- * Mittens or gloves– hockey gloves are preferred for the Beginning Hockey class.
- * Warm & comfortable clothing– beginning level Tots/Snowplow Sam participants are encouraged to wear snow pants, otherwise, long pants and a jacket or sweatshirt are sufficient; Jump & Spin participants are encouraged to wear figure skating attire.
- * Helmets– are strongly recommended for beginning skaters of all ages. Hockey helmets are preferred, but properly fitted bike or ski helmets are acceptable. Hockey helmets with a face mask are required for Beginning Hockey participants.
- * Hockey Stick– this applies to Beginning Hockey participants only.
